PAYROLL DEDUCTION

I hereby authorize Belen Consolidated Schools (BCS) to deduct from the pay due me one (1) deduction per 24 pay periods representing BFSE membership dues in the amount certified to the BCS Board, in writing, by the Belen Federation of School Employees and remit to the BFSE. Payroll deductions will continue unless revoked in writing by me to BFSE and BCS payroll office not later than 30 days prior to the effective date of revocation. The BCS Board assumes no responsibility in connection with this authorized deduction except to act as remitting agent in forwarding the amount deducted to the BFSE. BFSE membership will discontinue for those employees going on extended leave of absence. Employees returning from such leave must re-enroll to re-establish BFSE membership.

BFSE COPE DEDUCTION

I hereby authorize BCS to deduct from my pay the above designated sum per 24 pay periods and forward that amount to the Belen Federation of School Employees Committee on Political Education (COPE).

This authorization is signed freely and voluntarily, and not out of fear of reprisal. I will not be favored or disadvantaged because I exercise this right. I understand this money will be used by BFSE/COPE to make political contributions to candidates who represent the best interests of public school employees.

BFSE/COPE may engage in joint fund-raising efforts with the AFL-CIO.

This voluntary authorization may be revoked at any time by notifying the Belen Federation of School Employees Committee on Political Education (BFSE COPE) in writing of the desire to do so.

Contributions or gifts to BFSE COPE are not deductible as charitable contributions for Federal Income Tax purposes.

Dues paid to BFSE may not be deductible for Federal Income Tax purposes; however, under limited circumstances, dues may qualify as a business expense.
